Reviewing the past year in preparation for this newsletter, a theme emerged. God answered many prayers! With this report we include our deep appreciation for your prayers and financial support!

Here are a few areas of answered prayer:

Return to Panamá

During itineration we ministered virtually from home in San Diego in SoCal (Kirk's district). Later we finalized itineration from Springfield in SoMo (Yvonne's district). In spite of the pandemic disruption and restrictions, we received full funding to return to Panamá—thanks to

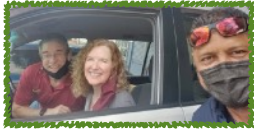


many of you! The actual return trip had to be rescheduled a couple times. While waiting we

mine. Recently he was voted into national executive leadership and is spearheading training efforts for the AG of Panamá generational mentoring emphasis.

Being back in Panamá, it was good to join good friend Pastor Bill Wilbur and his family in Gamboa for the Good Friday Service (bilingual). It was the first in-person service back inside the building in a year! Yvonne and Tony led worship, and Kirk shared speaking duties with Pastor Bill.

Resume Mentoring

It is so gratifying to see that everywhere we look people are talking about mentoring. Panamá's AG Superintendent Rev. Johny Saucedo has made "pass the baton to the next

What the Lord has placed on our hearts these past few years for kids ministry seems to fit perfectly: future fine arts training for students preparing them to minister using their God-given gifts and talents, plus the established *Amigo Mentor Panamá* program connecting believers with kids from hard places.

Yvonne's friend Graciela Mauad became Director of SENNIAF (Panamá Child Protective Services, in charge of all orphanages). Thanks to her open door invitation, we resumed the *Amigo Mentor Panamá* program at a transitional center meeting with the children on a weekly basis.



Following our visit to Pastor Juan Barria’s church, his wife Roxana joined us to minister at the center. Kirk shared the Bible story of the little lost lamb.



During summer vacation Tony and his girlfriend Paola led the creative choreography portion of our weekly visit to the transitional center. High energy Bible songs with fun dance moves—the kids loved it!

Finally, our Paint Church Life Group decided to partner with us to help the first center where Amigo Mentor Panamá began. So we coordinated with the director and our life group volunteers to plant a garden to beautify the



entryway sidewalk. The children planted flower seeds and hung up their decorated pots. With a little



assistance digging the holes they also ringed the walkway with decorative durable plants.

Resettle home/ ministry base

Even though it took a little longer than we anticipated, the Lord did help us find a



suitable house to rent. It fits our needs as empty nesters, plus allows opportunity for ministry training, fine arts and hosting guests.

We look forward to filling up the house this Christmas with all four of our kids. A blessing we don’t take for granted!
